'Thomas-Related Content' refers to content relevant to the following Academia "research interests" (greater to lesser): Gospel of Thomas, Nag Hammadi, Early Christian Apocryphal Literature, and Coptic Studies.

Column meanings in the table below are as follows (caveat: Academia data is not entirely reliable):
 AR: AuthorRank – "a function of the PaperRanks of the papers on the author's profile" (default = 1.0)
 follrs: number of Academia followers (rounded to nearest 5)
 pprs: "Papers" - an Academia term for any item posted there
 (FYI: The Academia note "Top x%" that appears on some profiles is based on the last 30 days only.)
